We asked a few of our leaders to share their recommendations on what to keep in mind in the excitement on Match Day and as residency training begins (particularly for those in radiology). Take a

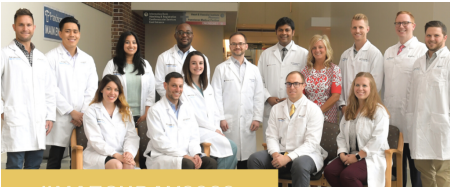
