Theranostics is a specialized field of medicine dedicated to the diagnosis and treatment of disease using targeted radioactive compounds called radiopharmaceuticals. Different radiopharmaceuticals target different types of diseased tissues. The radiopharmaceuticals are typically infused into the bloodstream, where they seek out and attach to the targeted diseased tissue everywhere in the body. Once the radiopharmaceuticals have attached to the diseased tissue, they can either be used to identify the tissue through imaging or eliminate the tissue by delivering a minute amount of radiation directly to the diseased cells. This approach minimizes damage to surrounding healthy tissues.

All treatments offered through the ARA Theranostics Center are FDA-approved. Most are covered by Medicare and many insurance groups. The ARA Theranostics Center is located at <u>ARA Midtown</u>.
